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## CHARGES CLOSED WITH FIREARM INVOLVEMENT AND REFERRED TO COURT BY MONTH, JANUARY 2019 – APRIL 2022, FAYETTE COUNTY

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May 18, 2022

### Statistics Request Overall Description

On May 11, 2022, WLEX 18, requested a report of complaints closed and referred to court with firearm involvement by month from January 2019 to April 2022 in Fayette County.

Charges were compiled from AOC CDWCMS, the case management and information system used by AOC Court Designated Workers (CDW), and this data was filtered to include charges closed during January 2019 to April 2022 within complaints in Fayette County.

Note that for this report, a “firearm involved charge” is a charge which meets any of the following criteria:

- The weapon listed in CDWCMS was either a pistol, a shotgun, or a rifle
- The AOC Offense Category associated with the UOR code and charge description was “Handgun”

This would mean that any incident with a pistol, shotgun, or rifle involved would show up in the report regardless of the nature of the charges. If there is no pistol, shotgun, or rifle entered into CDWCMS and the offense also does not fall into the “Handgun” category, it is not captured in this report.

### Statistical Table

The line graph provides the number of charges with firearm involvement closed by month from January 2019 – April 2022, which were referred to court. Each point on the line chart represents the number of complaints with charges involving firearm disposed per month.

The table is the tabular version of the data represented in the figure. The left side of the table lists each year while the columns list each month. Reading the table across shows the number of charges each month for a single year. Reading the table down shows the number of charges for a particular month for each year in the report.

### Statistical Analysis Considerations

- The statistical information presented is a snapshot in time as of May 18, 2022.
- Counts of charges do not equal a count of complaints, since a complaint may have multiple charges.

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### Statistical Table

- To protect the confidentiality of CDW complaints, any instances in which fewer than six records would be reported have been concealed. A blank entry should be read as a value of 0-5 complaints/charges/youth.

	Firearm Involved Charges	As indicated within CDWCMS, includes charges involving a pistol, shotgun, or rifle used in the commission of the offense and includes any charges listed in the AOC Offense Category: Handgun. A list of firearm involved charges resulting from the query is included in the methodology.
	Charge Close Date	The date when the charge close reason was entered into CDWCMS. Not every charge in a single complaint has to be closed at the same time. This report includes charge close dates from January 2019 through April 2022.
	Complaint County	The county in which the complaint was filed. This report only includes complaints filed in Fayette County.
	Charge Close Group	Indicates the reason the charge was closed, grouped into one of three possible categories: dismissed (successful diversion), dismissed (other), or formal court referral. This report only includes charges closed as a formal court referral.
	Charge Close Reason	Indicates the reason why the charge was closed. Charge close reasons in this report include the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unsuccessful Diversion</li> <li>• CDW Refer for Formal Court Process</li> <li>• Formal Court Referral by County Attorney</li> <li>• Formal Court Referral by Judge</li> <li>• Youthful Offender Referral</li> </ul>

A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "\*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.

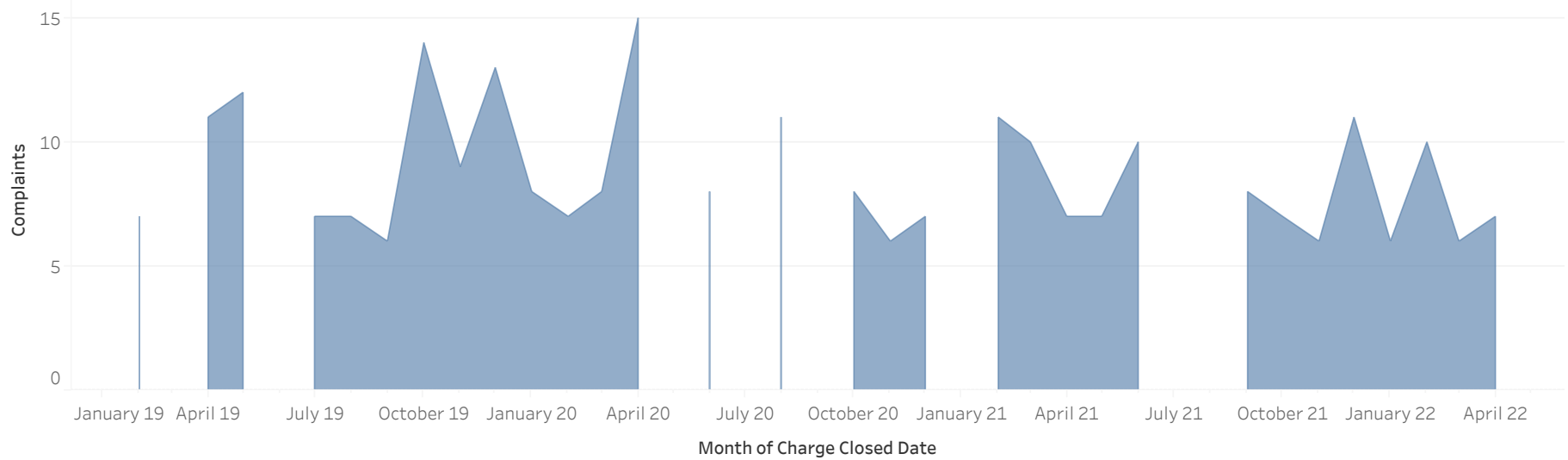
