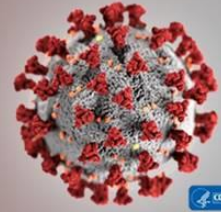

Signage Notice for June 9, 2020

Justices, Judges, Circuit Court Clerks & AOC Executive Officers and Managers:

New public entrance signs about reopening procedures now available in 12 languages

Signs should be posted in most commonly used languages

The three court facility signs you received to post June 1 for our reopening are now available in 12 languages. Under Supreme Court [Administrative Order 2020-43](#) and [Administrative Order 2020-44](#), these signs must be posted at public entrances to notify the public of certain requirements that must be met to enter and remain in the facility.

These three signs are:

- Sign 1, P-180, June 1, 2020: Restrictions on Entering Court Facilities
- Sign 2, P-181, June 1, 2020: Limitations on In-Person Services
- Sign 3, P-182, June 1, 2020: Limitations on Purses and Bags (for court facilities without X-ray machines)

Thank you to the AOC Department of Language Access for translating the signs into the languages most frequently encountered in courthouses and judicial centers statewide. Signs should be posted at entrances to reflect the languages most commonly encountered in that facility. Near the top of Sign 2, you should add contact information for the Office of Circuit Court Clerk in the gray-highlighted area. The signs are 8.5x11 and can be printed in your office by clicking on the language below:
