## Update for February 4, 2021

Justices, Judges, Circuit Court Clerks and Kentucky Court of Justice Personnel:

### How to Determine Your Eligibility for COVID-19 Vaccinations

I continue to encourage all of you to get a COVID-19 vaccination as soon as you're eligible based on Kentucky's [distribution plan](#). You will need to arrange to get vaccinated by a provider in your community. The Administrative Office of the Courts has not been authorized to schedule vaccines on behalf of our employees or elected officials.

Gov. Beshear has advised me that KCOJ personnel have been designated as Phase 1 C essential workers. Anyone over age 70 and/or in a high-risk group will be eligible to receive the vaccine in Phase 1 B when it's available in their community.

#### Vaccine Eligibility Survey

To find out when you'll be eligible for a vaccination and to sign up for notifications, you can take the [Kentucky Department for Public Health's COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility Survey](#). You should answer "Legal" to the question "Do you currently work or volunteer full- or part-time in any of the following?" to denote that you are an essential employee for the Kentucky Court of Justice (see screenshot). You will also be asked your age and if you have any high-risk medical conditions. Depending on those factors, you may be eligible for the vaccine sooner than allowed by your 1 C essential worker status.
