Statistics Request Description

On September 25, 2025, Research & Statistics received a request for a report examining trends over time in the rate of filing of Delinquency and Youthful Offender cases including information about violent offenses. This report additionally includes information about Circuit Criminal cases filed against adult defendants as a point of comparison for these trends. To define violent offenses, Research & Statistics used the definition from KRS 439.3401(1).¹

Please note that this statute was amended significantly during the 2024 regular legislative session. The logic used in this report to identify violent charges uses the current definition retroactively. Some offenses considered violent under the current definition were not considered violent on the dates of alleged offenses. Some offenses are only considered violent if convicted when the crime involves the serious injury or death of a victim or when another person is present during the commission of burglary. Since these factors are not captured as reportable data elements, this set of offenses is considered *Potentially Violent* within this report.

CourtNet, which provides a summary of court cases statewide, was queried for cases filed between 1/1/2015 and 12/31/2024 within the following categories:

- **Circuit Criminal Cases:** Case Number Type *CR*, and
- **Delinquency Cases:** Case Number Type *J* (Juvenile) cases including a charge of at least one Public Offense and no Uniform Juvenile Codes indicating accusations of Dependency, Neglect, or Abuse.

Youthful Offender cases are identified as Circuit Criminal cases in which the top defendant party was 10-18² years of age as of the date of the earliest *Charge Date* for any charge in the case. All other

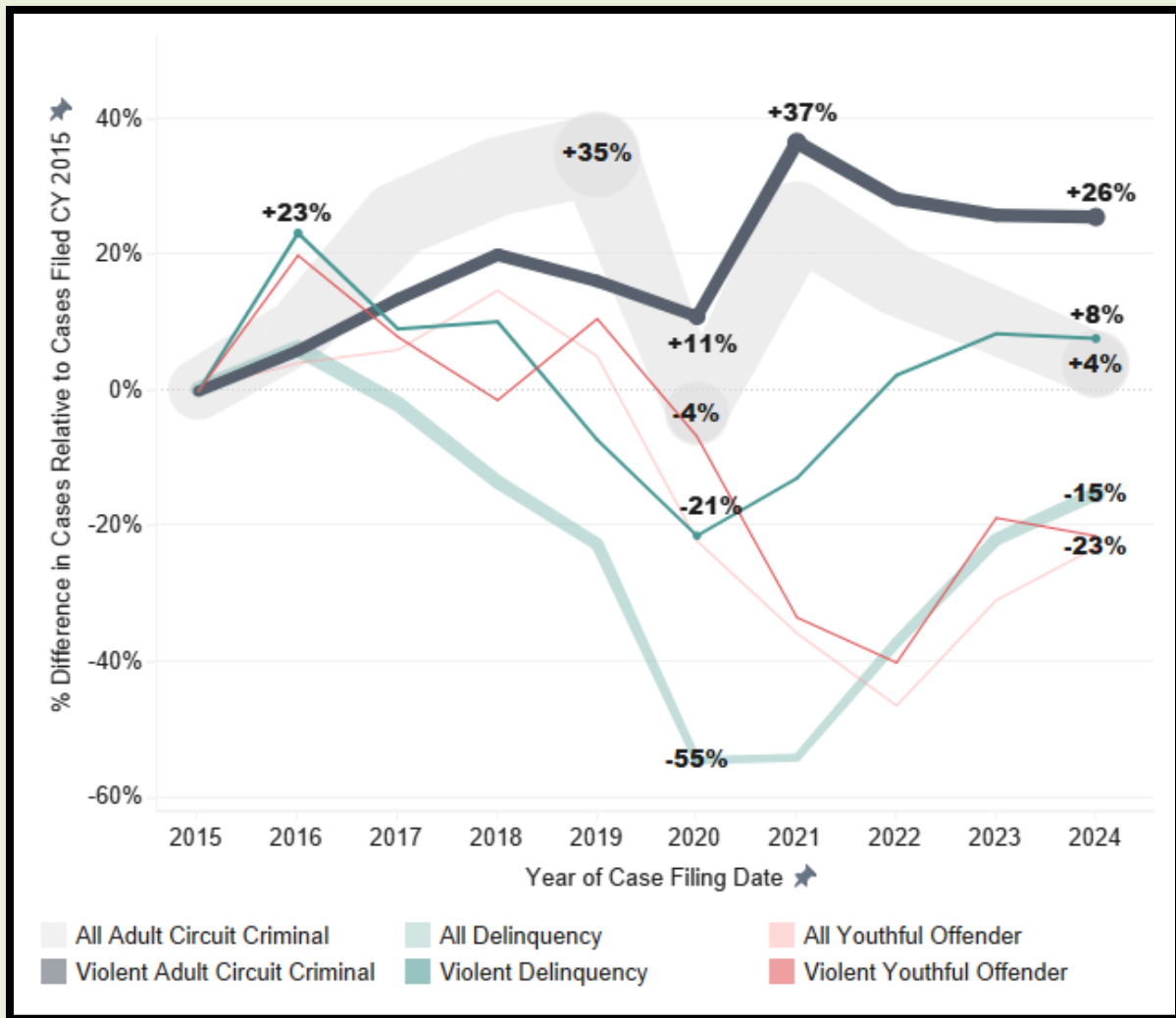
Statistics Request Description

Circuit Criminal cases are assumed in this report to be filed against adults, including 14,522 cases (3.7% of CR cases) with missing or implausible dates of birth (negative age, age 0, over 100, etc.).

Statistical Report

The following visualization demonstrates that patterns for the relative change of adult criminal, youthful offender, and juvenile delinquency cases have diverged within the past ten years.

Figure 1: Percent difference in number of cases filed relative to the number of cases filed in CY 2015. *Violent* here includes Definitely Violent and Potentially Violent charges.



This visualization allows for the comparison of relative trends for groups of cases for which the actual numbers of cases are very different. The line chart presents the percent change in the number of cases filed in each of the indicated categories with vertical position representing the percent of each year's number of cases filed relative

to the number filed in CY 2014. The size of each mark represents the relative number of cases in each group. The associated numbers of cases and percent differences are included in Table 1.

Both total and violent Youthful Offender case filing rates declined during the pandemic years (2020 and 2021) and while the rates have increased since then, they remain lower than the rates of pre-pandemic years. Overall Delinquency case filing rates declined in the years preceding the pandemic, declined further during the pandemic, and have increased since the pandemic to rates approximately the same as the filing rate of 2019. The decrease in the rate of filing of delinquency cases including violent or potentially violent charges decreased less during the pandemic and likewise have since returned to rates comparable to those seen in 2019, which are slightly higher than the rates from 2015.

The rate of filing of Adult Circuit Criminal cases steadily increased in the years leading up to the pandemic. Delinquency and Youthful Offender cases showed an even greater rate increase from 2015 to 2016, but after this diverged from the pre-pandemic rate increase seen in Adult Circuit Criminal cases. From 2015 to 2019, rates for Adult Circuit Criminal cases with violent or potentially violent charges increased less than the rate of Adult Circuit Criminal cases overall. From 2019 to 2020, rates fell, with a smaller decrease for violent cases compared to cases generally. Then there is a sharp increase from 2020 to 2021. The author's conjecture is that the spike in 2021 is likely in part procedural, with cases that would have otherwise been filed earlier being delayed until the restoration of criminal jury trials in 2021. The largest month-to-month increase as well as the highest overall number of Circuit Criminal cases filed in a single month was March-to-April 2021, with an increase from 2,581 cases filed in March to 5,282 cases filed in April.³ Following 2021, there has been a decrease in rates of Circuit Criminal cases overall, with rates in 2024 returning to the approximate rates seen in 2015. Cases with violent or potentially violent charges, however, have decreased only slightly since 2021. If the decrease from 2021 to 2022 can be attributed to the 2021 spike following the courts' reopening, the general pattern in the rates of cases with violent or potentially violent charges shows stability.

The tables on the subsequent pages present additional information. Table 1 includes the underlying numbers associated with the data presented in Figure 1 with cases including Definitely Violent charges counted separately from cases including Potentially Violent charges but no Definitely Violent charges. Table 2 presents numbers of cases and charges of Definitely Violent offenses grouped by Offense Category. Table 3 presents numbers for Potentially Violent offenses.

Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried (10/1/2024).
- Youthful Offender cases are frequently - but not always - preceded by a Delinquency case and Grand Jury Indictment. As such, some of the Delinquency cases and Youthful Offender cases included in this report may represent the same incidents.

Wanton Endangerment charges comprise 97% of the charges reported in the Assault/Abuse category and 86% of the charges reported in the table. Charges of 1st Degree Burglary or the attempt thereof comprise 8% of the charges in the table and the entirety of the reported Theft Category. Charges of Unlawful Imprisonment comprise 3% of the charges in the table and the entirety of the Kidnapping category. The charges reported as All Others are 1st Degree Escape and 1st Degree Rioting. Charges of Non-Violent offenses within the reported cases are not included in the reported counts of charges.
