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Statistics Request Overall Description

On October 20, 2025, Research and Statistics received a request for an aggregate report of CDW complaints since 1/1/2020 broken down by Judicial Supreme Court Region (with Fayette Separate from the 5th District) and LGBTQ Status.

The AOC Court Designated Workers Case Management System (CDWCMS), the case management and information system used by Court Designated Workers, was queried for complaints where the most recent preliminary inquiry was completed with youth participation on or after 1/1/2020. To limit results to completed inquiries involving youth participation, only inquiries that were closed on Screen 10 or 15 of the CDWPI web application were included. This was a necessary filter on the data, as LGBTQ Status is self-identified by youths as part of the preliminary inquiry process, so those who declined to participate or did not complete the interview did not have the opportunity to answer the question.

Statistical Report (25_CDW6028)

This report contains seven pages of statewide data on complaints where the most recent preliminary inquiry was completed with youth participation on or after 1/1/2020.

Page 1 presents a pair of horizontal percentage bar charts and an associated cross-tabulation. Each of the bar charts have a separate bar for each Complaint Region, with the bars themselves being split into segments by LGBTQ Status. Each status is represented by a different color. The chart in the top left of the page shows the percentage of complaints by LGBTQ Status for each Region while the chart in the top right of the page shows the quantity of complaints by LGBTQ Status. The cross-tabulation at the bottom of the page presents the same information as the bar charts but with totals by region and LGBTQ Status.

Page 2 contains a cross-tabulation with counts and percentages of complaints by Preliminary Inquiry Year, Complaint Region, and LGBTQ Status.

Statistical Report (25_CDW6028)

Pages 3-4 contain the same information as pages 1-2 but limited to status complaints.

Pages 5-6 contain the same information as pages 1-2 but limited to public complaints.

Page 7 contains a map of Complaint Regions by County.

Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried: 11/12/2025.
- Counts of complaints do not necessarily represent counts of unique youths, as the same youth may have multiple complaints.
- Data for Calendar Year 2025 is incomplete as the report was run before the conclusion of the year.

	Preliminary Inquiry Interview	The preliminary inquiry is an interview with a youth who is the subject of a complaint. KRS 610.030 ¹ requires a preliminary inquiry to determine whether the interests of the child or the public require that formal action be taken. The Court Designated Worker is required by statute to conduct evidence-based screenings including a validated risk or needs assessment to determine if services are appropriate and what level of intervention is needed. If the youth consents to the interview, the preliminary inquiry includes the GAIN-SS and questions about their living situation, education, health, and other pertinent information. These questions are used to identify situations of potential abuse and neglect or the need for other services. The GAIN-SS is a validated screener instrument that flags youth as potentially having one or more behavioral or mental disorders.
	Preliminary Inquiry Interview Step	The screen in which the Preliminary Inquiry was completed, if completed. The steps where the Interview can be considered complete are:

RESEARCH AND STATISTICS UOR CODE DISCLAIMER

The Kentucky State Police (KSP) assigns the Kentucky Uniform Crime Reporting Codes (UOR Codes) to criminal offenses in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The KSP official list of UOR Codes by KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the KSP's website at www.kentuckystatepolice.org.

The AOC assigns and maintains codes that are used within the Court of Justice Case Management System for statistical and reporting purposes. These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. The AOC official list of UOR Codes with KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the Court of Justice Website at courts.ky.gov/aoc/statisticalreports. The AOC UOR Code Listing is for informational purposes only and the information is subject to change, reprogramming, modifications of format, and availability at the direction of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.

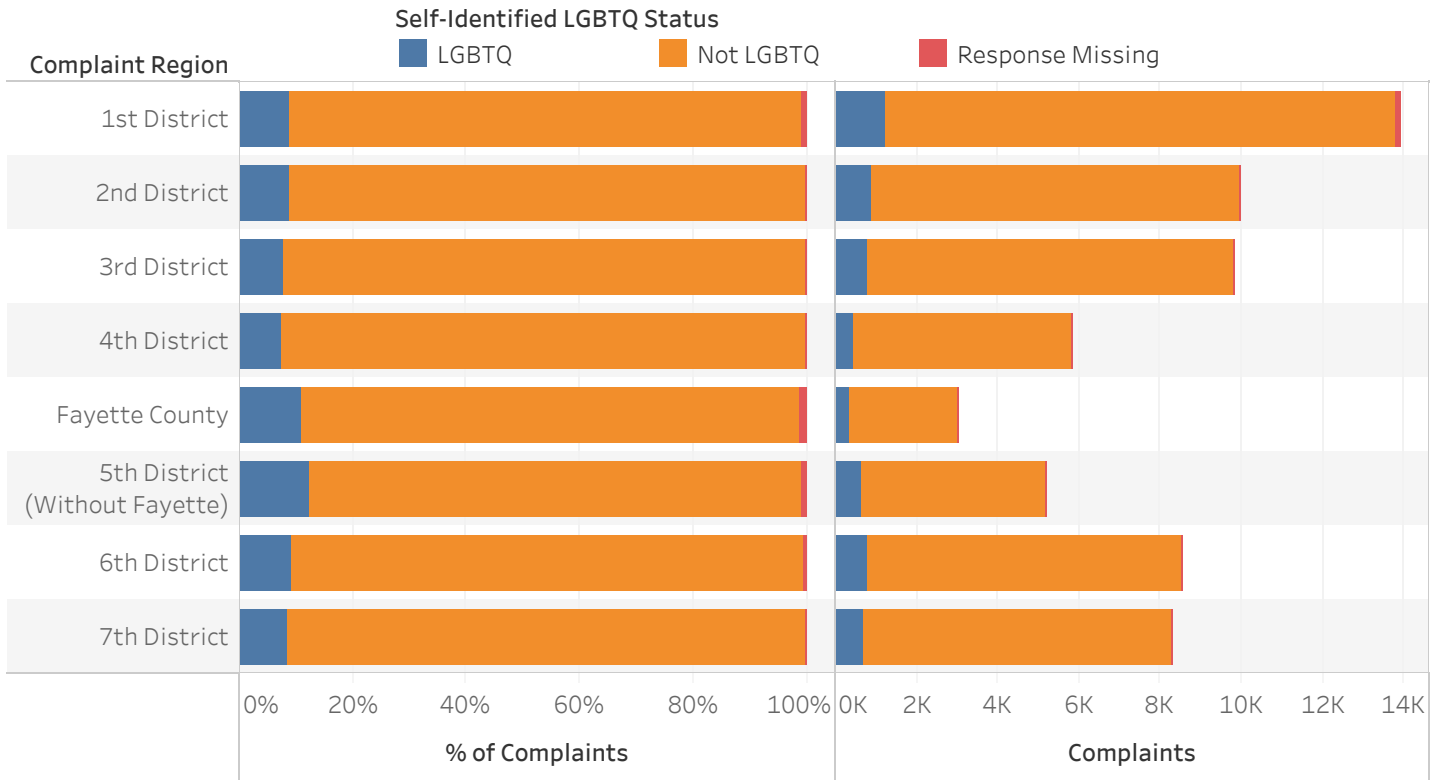

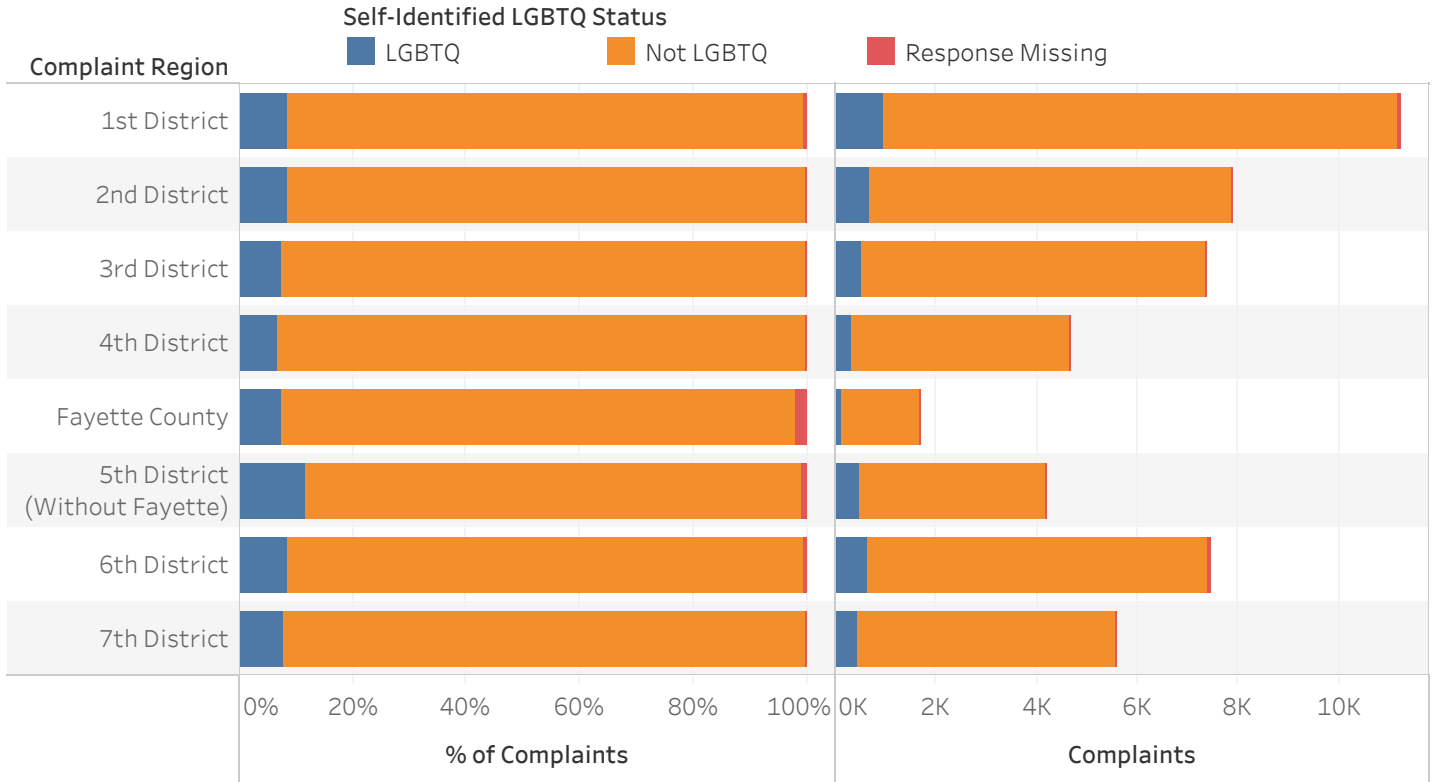

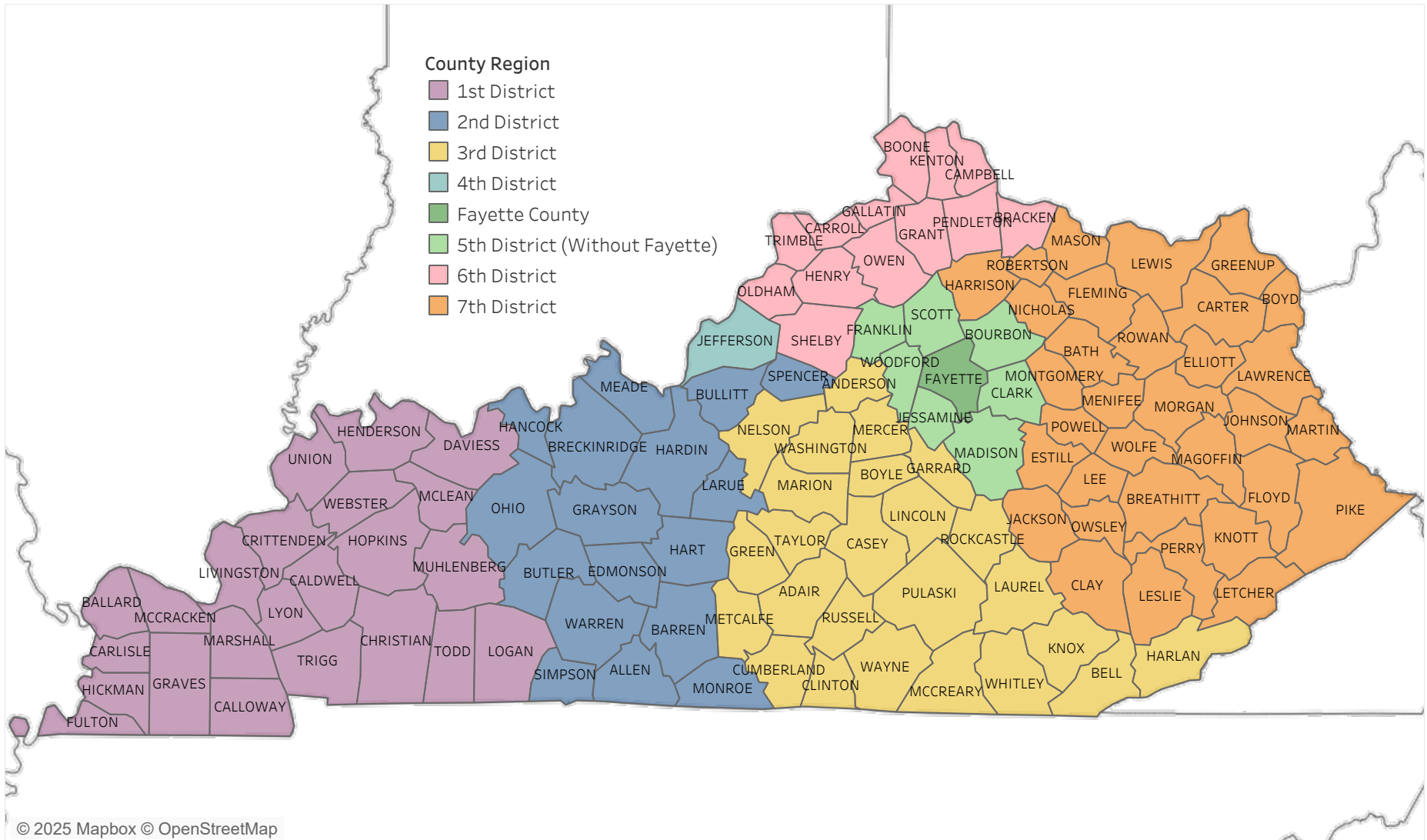
