Statistics Request Overall Description

On April 25, 2023, the Commonwealth's Attorney requested from Research and Statistics Circuit Criminal cases filed in Bullitt County for CY 2022 and CY 2023 (YTD).

CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for Circuit Criminal (CR) cases filed in Bullitt County from 1/1/2022 through 5/2/2023 by highest offense within the case grouped by AOC Offense Category. Added offense were excluded.

Statistical Table (23_RS3055 & 23_RS3057)

Report 23_RS3055 provides Circuit Criminal cases filed during timeframe 1/1/2022 – 5/2/23 in Bullitt County sorted by AOC Offense Category, excluding added offenses.

Report 23_RS3057 An additional report is provided to additionally breakdown the number of Circuit Criminal cases filed during the timeframe of 1/1/2022 - 5/2/2023 by each individual UOR Descriptions under each of the AOC Offense Categories, excluding added offenses.

Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- > The statistics presented in the attached tables are a snapshot in time, as of the run date.
- > The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers. Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals. An individual can have multiple cases.
- > Charges consist of all original and amended charges within a case. Added offenses were excluded.
- > A circuit criminal case may consist of one or multiple charges. The count of highest felony charges within a case is based on the UOR charge level and the maximum number charge entity number.
- Charges can be amended to another charge with the same class/level or may be amended to a higher/lower charge class/level.

The AOC assigns and maintains codes that are used within the Court of Justice Case Management System for statistical and reporting purposes. These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. The AOC official list of UOR Codes with KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the Court of Justice Website at https://kycourts.gov/AOC/Information-and-Technology/Analytics/Pages/default.aspx. The AOC UOR Code Listing is for informational purposes only and the information is subject to change, reprogramming, modifications of format, and availability at the direction of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.
