Statistics Request Overall Description

On January 29, 2026, Research and Statistics received a request for an aggregate report on dispositions and sentences of specified child pornography-related charges disposed 1/1/2015 through 12/31/2025 in Jefferson County.

CourtNet, the database that provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for disposition and sentencing information for specified ***matter portraying a sexual performance by a minor*** offenses disposed from 1/1/2015 – 12/31/2025 within Circuit Court (CR) cases in Jefferson County. Cases were selected based on case number type (CR) for Circuit Criminal cases. A list of base charges included in the query is provided on the final page of this report. While the list reflects only the base offenses, the query parameters also encompassed applicable inchoate variants of those offenses (e.g., attempt, conspiracy, facilitation) for purposes of the analysis presented herein.

Sentencing Information

This report reflects sentence data as ordered at sentencing. Any subsequent modifications resulting from probation violations, revocations, or shock probation are not incorporated.

Sentence Report Limitations

- Sentence information is reported only for the charges disposed which have a sentence entered in CourtNet.
- The data does not represent the total overall term of the sentence imposed for any given case or individual. When multiple sentences are imposed, the court may order sentence terms to run concurrently or consecutively. The concurrent/consecutive indicator does not identify the specific charge(s) or case(s) to which the designation applies. Sentence lengths reflect only the jail or prison term (JORP) associated with each individual charge and do not account for whether sentences were ordered to run concurrently or consecutively.
 - Concurrent Sentence: Terms served simultaneously with another sentence; may be fully or partially concurrent.
 - Consecutive Sentence: Terms served only after completion of another sentence; may be fully or partially consecutive.
- When a sentence is set aside or vacated, the associated sentence data are removed from the case record and cannot be reported.

- The report may exclude sentence information for partially expunged cases– those in which one or more charges, but not all charges within the case, have been expunged. This occurs because the sentence information associated with the expunged UOR code(s) is removed during this expungement process.

CourtNet Sentence Structure

Sentencing is recorded at the charge level, as reflected in the case management system. The total incarceration term imposed may be modified by subsequent alternatives such as suspension, probation, conditional discharge, or home incarceration.

The Following Factors Affecting Sentence Term and are not Considered:

- **Probation Violations and Revocation**
A probation violation occurs when a defendant fails to comply with court-ordered supervision conditions. Violations of probation and supervised release may result in “Probation Revocation” which is the annulment, cancellation, or reversal of an act, regarding probation or supervised release. The term generally refers to the judicial act of canceling the supervision in response to the offender violation the terms of supervision and impose a term of incarceration.
- **Shock Probation (KRS 439.265)**
Shock probation permits conditional early release from incarceration prior to expiration of the full term. Upon violations of conditions, the individual may be returned to custody to serve the remainder of the sentence. Modifications resulting from shock probation are not reflected in this report.
- **Conditional Discharge (checkbox entries):** In addition to the length of time conditionally discharged that is provided, the Case Management System contains a check box indicating Conditional Discharge. Data from this check box is not provided.

Statistical Reports (26_RS3005)

The report includes six (6) pages of data on specified charges disposed between January 1, 2015, and December 31, 2025, within Jefferson County Circuit Criminal (CR) cases, including disposition outcomes and sentencing.

Note: No specified charges during the reporting period were sentenced to *Life, Death, or 25 Years No Parole* (as indicated by checkboxes in the case management system) in Jefferson County.

Page 1: Specified Offenses by Charge Disposition Category

Figure 1 displays a horizontal bar chart illustrating the distribution of charges by charge disposition type. The chart reports both charge-level and case-level counts, along with the percentage of charges disposed within each Charge Disposition Category (see below) by calendar year (CY). Each Charge Disposition Category is represented by a distinct color, as indicated in the accompanying legend.

Table 1 provides the cross-tabulation corresponding to Figure 1. Cases are counted under each Charge Disposition Category in which at least one charge within the case received that disposition. Because a single case may contain charges across multiple categories, case subtotals may exceed the actual overall number of cases. The grand total reflects the true overall count of cases.

Pages 2 & 3: Specified Offenses by UOR and Charge Disposition Category

Figure 2 displays a horizontal bar chart illustrating the count and percentage of charges disposed by Charge Disposition Category, further broken down by Charge UOR Code and Description.

Table 2 presents the corresponding cross-tabulation to Figure 2, providing the same information in tabular format. Additionally, a count of cases containing these charges is provided. Cases are counted under each combination of UOR Code and Charge Disposition Category applicable to at least one charge within a given case. This causes case subtotals to add up to a number larger than the actual overall total, the grand total has the actual overall total of cases.

Page 4: Specified Offenses by Sentence Ordered Time

Table 3 presents a cross-tabulation of charge counts by Sentence Ordered Time grouped in years (Less than 5 Years, 5-9 Years, 10-14 Years, 15-19 Years, 20-24 Years, 25+ Years, and No Incarceration Time Ordered), further broken down by Charge UOR Code and Description. Convictions that have been vacated, sealed, voided, or set aside may no longer contain sentence information and are therefore included in the *No Incarceration Time Ordered* category. Counts of distinct cases containing these charges are also provided. Cases are counted under each Sentence Ordered Time group associated with at least one applicable charge within the case. Because a single case may include charges that fall into multiple sentence groups, case subtotals may exceed the actual overall number of cases. The grand total in the right column reflects the true overall count of distinct cases.

Convictions with a sentence of Life, Death, or 25 Years Without Parole indicated by the corresponding checkboxes are excluded from this table.

Page 5: Alternative Sentence and Conditions by Sentence Penalty Ordered for Specified Offenses.

Table 4 presents a cross-tabulation providing counts of charges by Highest Penalty of Net Jail or Prison (JORP) sentence time. Counts of distinct cases containing those charges are also included. Convictions that have been vacated, sealed, voided, or set aside may no longer contain sentence information and are therefore categorized under *No Incarceration Time Ordered*. Sentence data is reported as entered in a combination of separate fields. Aggregation of these fields has been conducted. Amounts of time are entered in separate fields for years, months, days, and hours. To calculate the net sentence time, these were combined into a common unit (days). To determine the net sentence amount ordered, the amount of time suspended, conditionally discharged, and sentenced to home incarceration was subtracted from the original sentence amount imposed.

Note: None of the convictions during this timeframe resulted in a sentence of Life, Death, or 25 Years Without Parole.

Because a sentence may include more than one penalty, each charge is classified according to the first applicable penalty within the following hierarchy:

Penalty Hierarchy:

- Incarcerated Prison
 - Convictions indicating Life, Death, or 25 Years Without Parole via designated checkboxes are classified as **Incarcerated Prison**, regardless of any numerical sentence entry.
 - The net sentence time is greater than 365.242 days and the jail checkbox is not indicated.
- Incarcerated Jail
 - The jail checkbox is indicated, and the net sentence time is greater than 0 days.
 - The net sentence time is greater than 0 days and less than or equal to 365.242 days, regardless of the prison and jail checkboxes.
- Credit for Time Served (CTS) Only
 - The net sentence time equals 0 days and the credit for time served is greater than 0 days.
- Alternative: Home Incarceration
 - The net Home Incarceration time is greater than 0 days.
- Alternative/Other Penalty
 - The net sentence time equals 0 days, and the supervised and/or unsupervised probation time is greater than 0 days.
- Alternative: Conditional Discharge
 - The net sentence time equals 0 days, the supervised and unsupervised probation time both equal 0 days, and the conditional discharge time is greater than 0 days.
- Pay Fine Amount
 - The net fine amount is greater than 0.
 - The charge has a disposition of *Prepaid*.
- Pay Court Cost
 - The net court cost amount is greater than 0.
- No Sentence
 - No sentence screen exists for the conviction.
- **Default Classification**
 - **If none of the above conditions apply, the conviction is classified under Alternative/Other Penalty.**

Additionally, the cross-tabulation provides the counts of charges with alternative conditions. A single charge may have multiple conditions and is counted for under each applicable condition in the table. A list of possible alternative sentences can be found below. Alternative sentences with zero applicable charges are not shown in the table.

Page 6: List of Base UOR Codes Queried for this Report

This page consists of a list of base charges included in the query. While the list reflects only the base offenses, the query parameters also encompassed applicable inchoate variants of those offenses (e.g., attempt, conspiracy, facilitation) for purposes of the analysis presented herein.

Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried.
- Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals, as the same individual may have multiple cases.
- The sentence information in this report represents only the sentence ordered for that *charge* and does not provide the overall punishment for the case or for the individual.
- Sentence time entered represents the sentence ordered by the court. Subsequent modifications by the Department of Corrections to the length of incarceration is not reflected in this report.
- A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges within the case.
- The report may exclude sentence information for cases partially expunged – cases in which one or more charges but not all charges within the case have been expunged. This is because the Sentence information on the specific expunged UOR Code(s) within the case no longer exists and is removed during this expungement process.
- Charges include all ASCF Codes: 1-Attempt, 2-Solicitation, 3-Conspiracy, 4-Facilitation, 5-Complicity, and 6-Enhancement, where applicable.
- Sealed (SE) and Segregated (SG) case types were excluded.
- Case counts represent a distinct count of cases with at least one charge that meets specified criteria. Cases may consist of charges that meet different criteria within the table or visual, causing them to be counted under each specified criteria that applies to at least one specified charge within the case.

Figure 1: Specified Offenses by Charge Disposition Category

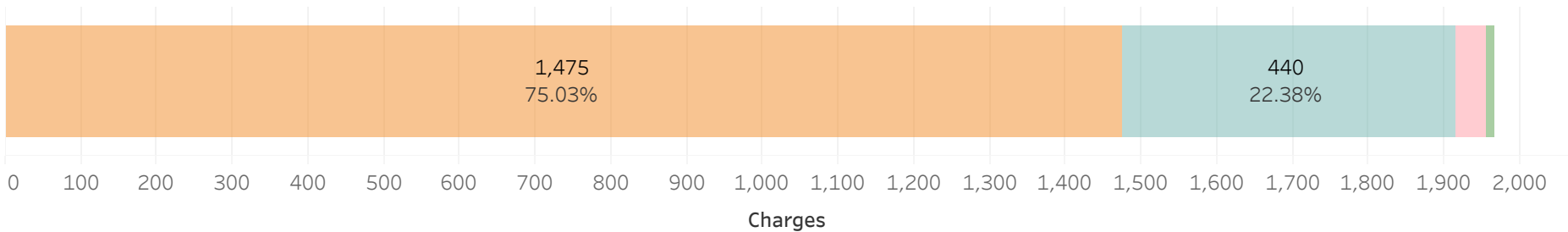

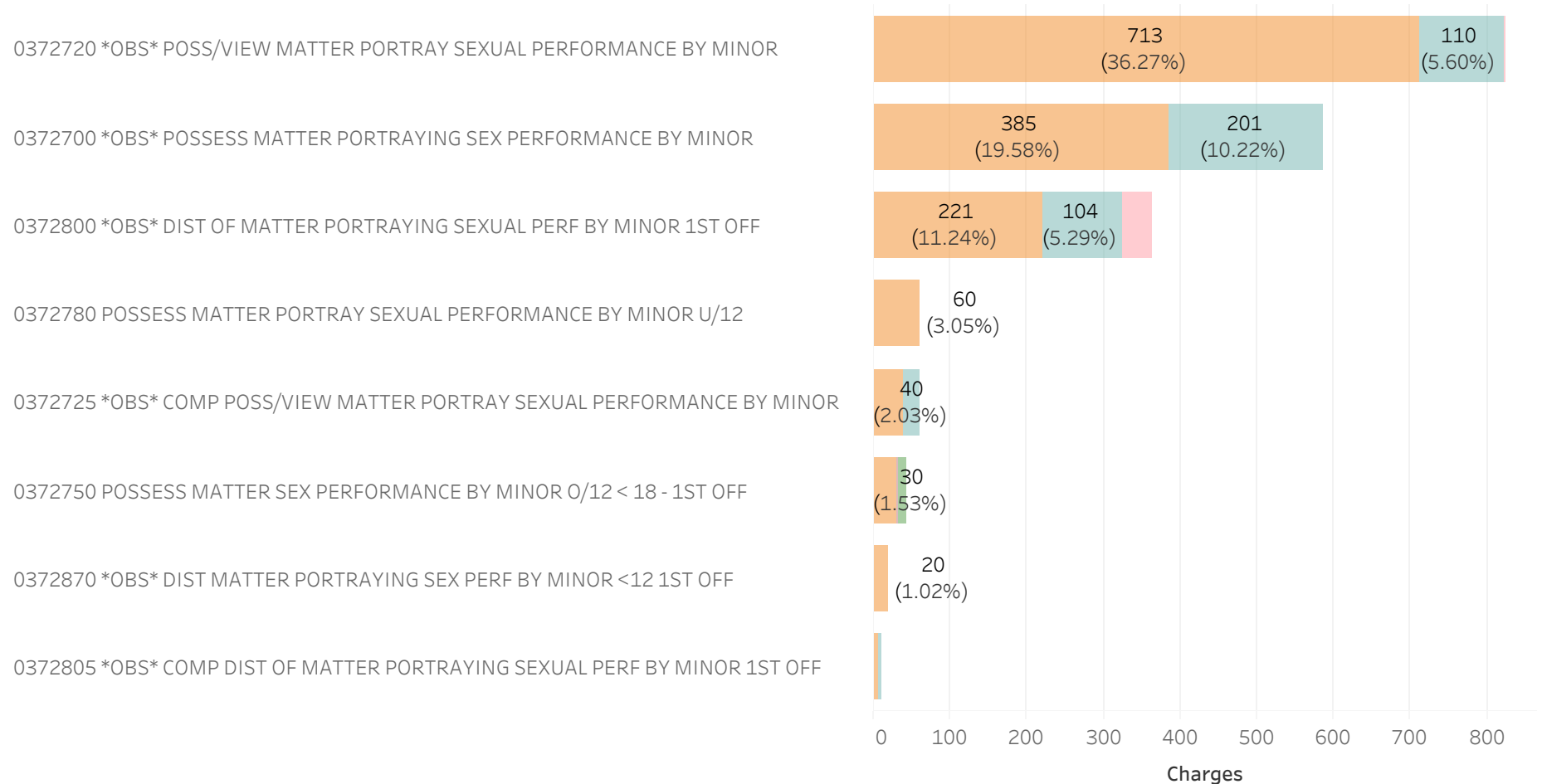
