Statistics Request Overall Description

On February 18, 2026, Research and Statistics received a request for charges disposed within Pulaski County District criminal cases between January 1, 2022, and December 31, 2025, in Pulaski County.

CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for Pulaski County District Criminal Cases (Case number type Circuit Criminal (CR), Felony (F), Misdemeanor (M), and Traffic (T)) having a grand jury disposition type as defined below, and a charge disposition date between January 1, 2022, and December 31, 2025.

Statistical Report (26_RS7002)

The requested data is presented as three (3) in a crosstabs.

Charges Disposed by Disposition: This crosstab is grouped by the Charge Disposition and is sorted by the Calendar Year of the Charge Disposition Date. Counts are provided for cases and charges.

Charges Disposed by Disposition Category and Disposition: This crosstab is grouped by the Charge Disposition Category and Charge Disposition and is sorted by the Calendar Year of the Charge Disposition Date. Counts are provided for cases and charges.

Charges Disposed by Disposition Category, Disposition and Case Number Type: This crosstab is grouped by the Charge Disposition Category, the Charge Disposition and the case Number Type and is sorted by the Calendar Year of the Charge Disposition Date. Counts are provided for cases and charges.

Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time as of March 17, 2026.
- A case may consist of two or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges associated with the case.

RESEARCH AND STATISTICS UOR CODE DISCLAIMER

The Kentucky State Police (KSP) assigns the Kentucky Uniform Crime Reporting Codes (UOR Codes) to criminal offenses in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The KSP official list of UOR Codes by KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the KSP's website at www.kentuckystatepolice.org.

The AOC assigns and maintains codes that are used within the Court of Justice Case Management System for statistical and reporting purposes. These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. The AOC official list of UOR Codes with KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the Court of Justice Website at courts.ky.gov/aoc/statistical-reports. The AOC UOR Code Listing is for informational purposes only and the information is subject to change, reprogramming, modifications of format, and availability at the direction of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.
