Statistics Request Description

On July 22, 2025, Research and Statistics received a request for a report of the rate of recidivism for youth complaints filed with Court Designated Workers (CDW) during Fiscal Years (FY) 2022, 2023, and 2024 statewide comparing complaints in terms of their eligibility for mandatory diversion and permissive diversion.

The AOC Court Designated Workers Case Management System (CDWCMS), the case management and information system used by Court Designated Workers, was queried for complaints filed between July 1, 2021, and June 30, 2024. The query included data from the most recent complete preliminary inquiry interview associated with each of these complaints. To identify recidivism, an additional query was performed for any resulting complaints to identify the presence of any subsequent complaint filed against the same youth.

Please note that the statistics provided herein are based on data collected from only the CDWCMS database, which captures offense data for offenses alleged to have been committed by individuals under the age of 18 at the time of the offense. The recidivism rate statistics reported do not include any charges filed against the same individual in court after they become an adult.

One-Year Recidivism Rate Statewide

These pages display a crosstab of data for FY 2022-2024 and include the two-year recidivism rate, a count of complaints, and a count of distinct youth for each year, broken down by the Diversion and Eligibility Groups described below.

One-Year Recidivism Rate Statewide Limited to Youth Ages 10-16

These pages display the same information included in *One-Year Recidivism Rate Statewide* but are limited to youth that are between the ages of 10-16 when a complaint was filed. Complaints against youth 17 or older are excluded from this page since a one-year recidivism window for these complaints would include time after the youth becomes an adult, and court cases filed after this point are not part of this recidivism definition.

Two-Year Recidivism Rate Statewide

These pages display a crosstab of data for FY 2022 and 2023 and include the two-year recidivism rate, a count of complaints, and a count of distinct youth for each year, broken down by the Diversion and Eligibility Groups described below.

Two-Year Recidivism Rate Limited to Youth Ages 10-15

These pages display the same information included in *Two-Year Recidivism Rate Statewide* but are limited to youth that are between the ages of 10-15 when a complaint was filed. Complaints against youth 16 or older are excluded from this page since a two-year recidivism window for these complaints would include time after the youth becomes an adult, and court cases filed after this point are not part of this recidivism definition.

- The statistical information presented is a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried (8/20/2025).
- Complaint counts do not equal a count of youth since a youth may have multiple complaints.
- Reported recidivism rates are the percentage of complaints followed by another complaint filed against the same youth within the indicated period of time (one or two years). This does not include criminal cases filed in court against these individuals after they become adults.
- A small number of complaints reported as *Diversion Ineligible* include diversion agreements created prior to the complaints' referral to court.

- CDW Court Referral: The complaint is ineligible for diversion and was referred to District Court by a Court Designated Worker without either of the conditions below.
- Mandatory Detention: The complaint is ineligible for diversion and was referred to District Court due to the requirement for Mandatory Detention per KRS 610.265(2)².
- Youthful Offender: The complaint is referred to court as a youthful offender per KRS 635.020³.

The data logic used to classify a complaint is described below. A complaint is classified in the first group for which the criteria below are satisfied in the order presented here.

- Youthful Offender: The complaint is closed with Close Reason Youthful Off Referral.
- Mandatory Detention: The complaint is closed with the Close Reason Mandatory Detention.
- CDW Court Referral: The complaint is closed with the Close Reason CDW Ref Case for Formal Proc.
- Mandatory Diversion: The complaint's preliminary interview flags the complaint as mandatory diversion eligible and the complaint includes at least one Diversion Agreement case action.
- Mandatory Diversion Override: The complaint's preliminary interview flags the complaint as mandatory diversion eligible and the complaint does not have any Diversion Agreement case actions.
- Permissive Diversion: The complaint has at least one Diversion Agreement case action and either the complaint's preliminary inquiry interview indicates the complaint is not eligible
