### Statistics Request Description

On May 14, 2026, Research and Statistics received a request for a report of the number of charges of the following offenses disposed from June 27, 2025 to December 31, 2025 or present within cases filed from June 27, 2025 to December 31, 2025:

Legislation creating these offenses went into effect on June 27, 2025.

The CourtNet database, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried statewide for charges of the specified offenses within cases with Case Filing Date from 1/1/2025 through 12/31/2025. A second statewide query was run for charges of the specified offenses with Charge Disposition Dates from 1/1/2025 through 12/31/2025.

### Statistical Reports 21\_RSX8000, 21\_RSX8001, and 21\_RSX8002

The document 21\_RSX4000 consists of a list of the Uniform Offense Reporting (UOR) Codes that were queried for Statistical Reports 21\_RSX4001 and 21\_RSX4002.

Statistical Report 21\_RSX8001 provides a count of the specified charges within cases statewide during CY2025 on or after 6/27/25. The report consists of three sections. The first section includes a pair of cross-tabulations – one with Circuit Court statistics and the other with District Court statistics. These tables present counts of individual charges and distinct cases grouped by county, offense, and CY of Case Filing Date. The second section, which is on the fourth page, includes a pair of tables with totals for all counties. There is one table with Circuit Court statistics and another with District Court statistics. Each is grouped by offense and the CY of Case Filing Date. The final section includes a single table with counts grouped by Jurisdiction and the CY of Case Filing Date.

Statistical Report 21\_RSX8002 provides a count of the specified charges disposed in statewide during CY2025 on or after 6/27/25. The query returned no results for Circuit Court charge dispositions during

this date range. The structure of the series of tables is the same as is in 21\_RSX8001 except that the counts are additionally grouped by Charge Disposition Category.

#### Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- The statistics presented are a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried: 5/14/2026.
- A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges associated with the case.
- Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals.
- Many but not all charges heard in Circuit Court were previously heard in District Court and indicted by grand jury. As such, the sum of charges in District and Circuit Court will count some indicted charges twice and totals from the two jurisdictions are presented separately
- Charges consist of all original and amended charges within a case.
- Charges include ASCF Codes: 1 - Attempt, 2 - Solicitation, 3 - Conspiracy, 4 - Facilitation, 5 - Complicity, 6 - Enhancement.
