### **Statistics Request Overall Description**

On October 4, 2023, Research and Statistics received a request for a report comparing recidivism rates for complaints filed between Fiscal Years (FY) 2013 and 2022 that include a violent offense per KRS 532.200. A supplemental list of offenses is included with this report.

The AOC Court Designated Workers Case Management System (CDWCMS), the case management and information system used by Court Designated Workers, was queried for all complaints filed between July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2022, having at least 1 charge identified as violent by KRS 532.200. The original complaints were checked to see if any subsequent complaint was filed within 365 days of the original complaint filing date.

In some instances, a Youth may have multiple subsequent complaints filed after the original complaint. For each of these multiple subsequent complaints filed, the complaint filing date was compared to the previous complaint's filing date to check for the recidivism criteria of having no more than 365 days difference between the filing dates.

The thickness of the horizontal line corresponds to the number of complaints filed for that fiscal year, along with the percent of those complaints that met the criteria for recidivism.

**Page 5:** This page displays the statewide recidivism statistics as a horizontal line graph, with a separate color representing the original complaint Intake Action and the <u>Subsequent Violent Offense Status</u> indicating whether the youth had a subsequent offense filed within 1 year of the original complaint filing date and if so, whether that subsequent offense was classified under KRS 532.200 as a Violent Offense. The thickness of the horizontal line corresponds to the number of complaints filed for that fiscal year, along with the percent of those complaints that met the criteria for recidivism.

**Page 6:** This page contains a single table presenting the same information as the Page 4 chart and is grouped by <u>Subsequent Violent Offense Status</u> and sorted by FY of the complaint filing date.

**Page 7:** This page contains a single table presenting the same information as the Page 5 chart and is grouped by <u>Intake Action and Subsequent Violent Offense Status</u> and sorted by FY of the complaint filing date.

**Pages 8-9:** These pages display the <u>AOC Offense Category of the original complaint</u> grouped by AOC Offense Category and whether youth associated with the original complaint filed had a subsequent

- The statistical information presented is a snapshot in time as of report run date.
- Counts of complaints do not equal a count of youth, since a youth may have multiple complaints.

	Original Complaint	In the evaluation of recidivism, the original complaint is the filed complaint tested for recidivism within 365 days of its filing date. All CDW complaints are evaluated for recidivism in this report – the analysis is not limited to a youth's first complaint.
	Complaint Filing Date	The date a complaint was filed with the Court Designated Work program. Complaint filing date is reported by Fiscal Year (July 1 through June 30).
	Intake Action	Custody or release action taken following intake of a juvenile. The actions indicate whether the child was taken into custody, released by either the CDW or peace officer, or detention was extended.




Recidivism Statistics by Subsequent Offense Status FY13-FY22



Recidivism Statistics by Subsequent Violent Offense Status FY13-FY22




