#### **Statistics Request Overall Description**

On July 22, 2025, a request was made to Research and Statistics for the number of juvenile status cases disposed fiscal years (FY) 2022-2025, statewide. Including the disposition type of the status offenses/contempt offenses within those cases disposed.

CourtNet, the statewide database of court cases, was queried twice: first for juvenile status offenses within the Status Case Category, with cases disposed between 7/1/2021 and 6/30/2025 (statewide). A second query was then conducted for Contempt offenses within those cases. *Note:* The Case Disposition Date is the first date on which all charges in a case have a disposition, including temporary dispositions (if any). The case disposition date is not supposed to change once entered, even if a disposition is later updated.

#### **Statistical Analysis Considerations:**

- > Data is provided from the CourtNet database.
- > The data provided is a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried.
- A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges associated with the case. A case may include one or more charges, this is most likely if the offenses are related to alcohol.
- > Counts of cases should not be considered counts of individuals, as some individuals could be involved with multiple filed cases.
- > Charges consist of all original and amended charges within a case.
- Charges include ASCF Codes: 1 Attempt, 2 Solicitation, 3 Conspiracy, 4 Facilitation, 5 Complicity, 6 Enhancement.

These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "\*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.



Chart 2: Status Cases with Contempt Offense(s) by Fiscal Year of Case Disposition



Chart 3: Contempt Charges within Status Cases Disposed FY 2022-2025 by Jurisdiction and Charge Disposition Category



Chart 4: Contempt Charges within Status Cases Disposed FY 2022-2025 by FY and Charge Disposition Category


