Statistics Request Overall Description

On September 11, 2024, Research and Statistics received a request from the Department of Public Advocacy for a report of complaints filed and closed during calendar year (CY) 2024 which contained status offenses. This includes breakdowns by status offense, month of complaint filing or closure, and complaint county. For those complaints which were closed with status offenses, the requestor asked that this be limited to complaints closed by a court referral.

Charges were compiled from AOC CDWCMS, the case management and information system used by AOC Court Designated Workers (CDW), and this data was filtered to include complaints filed or closed with status offenses between January 1, 2023 and August 31, 2024.

Statistical Report

The report consists of 20 total pages. The first page establishes a statewide baseline, showing a line chart comparing January to August of 2023 with the same time frame in 2024. This visual is limited to status offenses. Below the chart is a table which shows the individual status offenses by month in the year 2024.

Pages 2 through 12 contain a table which breaks down the number of status complaints filed in January-August 2024 by the status offense, county, and month. Because the table does not fit on a single page, it is split between pages with each page containing a limited number of counties. The end of the table on page 12 displays the statewide totals.

Pages 13 through 20 work similarly to the previous section, serving as one large table that is simply broken up across a series of pages. This table shows status complaints closed by formal court referral, broken down by status offense, county, and month. As with the previous section, the end of the table on page 20 displays the statewide totals.

Statistical Analysis Considerations

Statistical Report

- The statistical information presented is a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried (September 17, 2024).
- A count of charges does not equal a count of youth, as a complaint may have multiple charges and a youth may have multiple complaints.
- A complaint or a youth may have one or multiple charges, each of which may potentially fall into different rows/columns (level, offense, etc.) within a table. Complaints and youth are counted once in each row/column combination applicable to at least one charge associated with the complaint or youth. This causes subtotals of complaints and youth to add up to a count larger than the actual overall grand total.

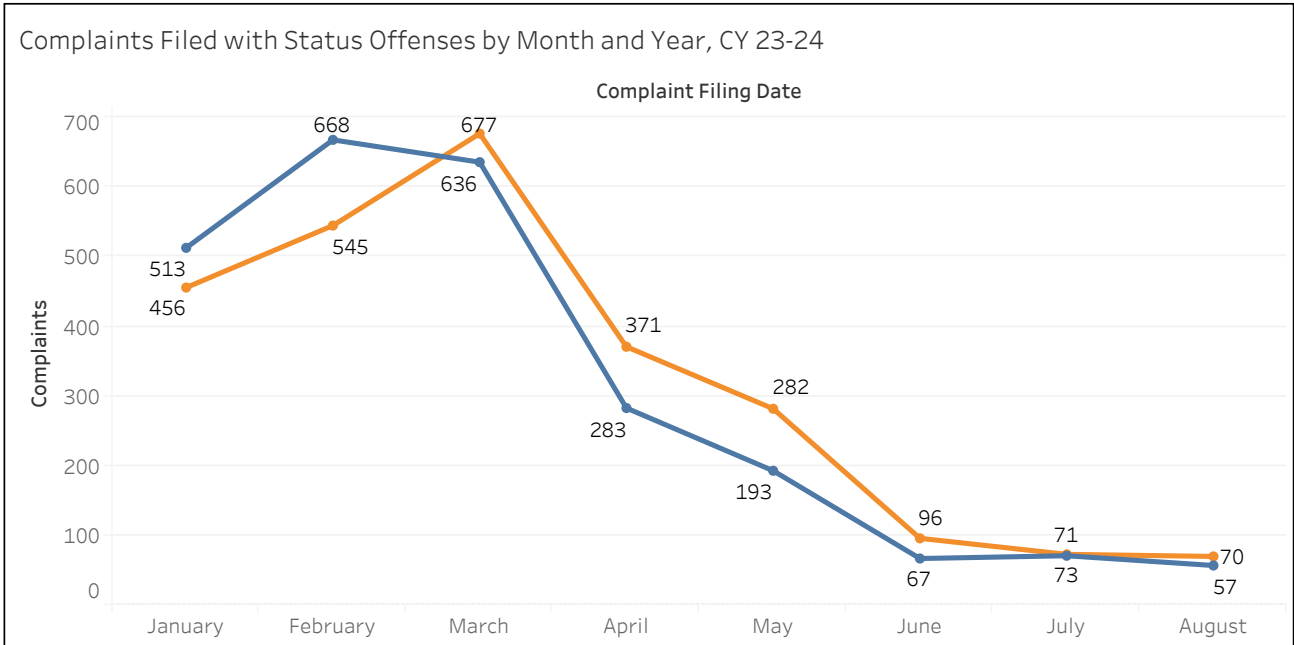
