Why Administrative Infrastructure Matters

The program depends on stable identity and consistent processes.

Transportation strain, process gaps, and system cycling affect outcomes.

DVR provides identity verification, due-process aligned systems, and statewide consistency.

Identity Integrity & Due Process

REAL ID-compliant verification and document authentication.

Fraud prevention and SSN/residency validation.

Accurate statewide records relied upon by courts and law enforcement.

Protects vulnerable individuals from identity misuse.

Reentry: IDs as a Gateway to Stability

Without an ID, individuals struggle to access housing, treatment, and employment.

Required for Medicaid, SNAP, SSI, banking, and recovery programs.
DVR coordinates with correctional partners to assist with ID issuance before release.

Removing administrative barriers reduces crisis cycling and recidivism.

Consistent and proactive programs and DLRO processes reduce repeat visits and documentation errors.
