NOTICE CONCERNING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF FAMILY JUDGE 8TH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, FAMILY DIVISION 3

The retirement of Honorable David A. Lanphear, effective October 1, 2025, created a vacancy in the office of Family Judge, 8th Judicial Circuit, Family Division 3, consisting of Edmonson and Warren counties. To be eligible to serve as a Circuit Family Judge you must:

- (a) be a citizen of the United States,
- (b) have been a resident of both the Commonwealth of Kentucky and of the circuit in which you seek appointment for two years next preceding taking office, and
- (c) be licensed to practice law in the courts of the Commonwealth as well as a licensed attorney for at least eight years.

Any person meeting these qualifications and desiring consideration for nomination to the Governor, or any citizen desiring to recommend a person or persons with these qualifications, *MUST notify the Judicial Nominating Commission by communicating the name(s) to the executive secretary on or before October 27, 2025, (see SCR 6.030).
