RE: Authorization for Extension of Uniform Schedule of Bail Pilot Project in Bell, Boyd, Boone, Butler, Campbell, Edmonson, Kenton, Ohio, and Pike Counties Until June 30, 2014

ORDER

Under Administrative Order 2009-14, a Uniform Schedule of Bail Pilot Project was authorized in Bell, Boyd, Boone, Butler, Campbell, Edmonson, Kenton, Ohio, and Pike Counties from January 1, 2010, to December 31, 2010. Such projects were then extended through June 30, 2011 under Administrative Order 2010-12, through June 30, 2012 under Administrative Order 2011-05, through June 30, 2013 under Administrative Order 2012-05, and through October 31, 2013 under Administrative Order 2013-09. The Supreme Court of Kentucky has now determined that it is necessary to extend the authorization for the Uniform Schedule of Bail Pilot Project in these pilot counties until June 30, 2014, to facilitate further study of the project and its performance following the implementation of legislation impacting the penal code and controlled substances.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that authorization for the Uniform Schedule of Bail Pilot Project in Bell, Boyd, Boone, Butler, Campbell, Edmonson, Kenton, Ohio, and Pike Counties is extended until June 30, 2014, and the Uniform Schedule of Bail to be used and applied in said counties during this further

test period shall be the Uniform Schedule of Bail, excepting that in Campbell County, the Class D felony Schedule shall not be used.

It is further ORDERED that Pretrial Services shall continue to assist, monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of said pilot project and shall prepare quarterly reports and summaries for the Supreme Court of Kentucky.
