

IN RE: PROTOCOL FOR MOTIONS SEEKING EMERGENCY RELIEF

ORDER

Pursuant to CR 76.34(4), any member of the Supreme Court of Kentucky may be designated by the Chief Justice to hear motions that do not finally dispose of an appeal or original action. In keeping with the practice of this Court and to ensure prompt and orderly resolution of motions seeking emergency relief pursuant to CR 65.09(3), CR 76.33, and CR 76.36(3), a protocol is hereby established that the Chief Justice is first contacted when such emergency motion and response are filed and ready for review. When the Chief Justice is unavailable to review the emergency motion, the Deputy Chief Justice shall be contacted to review the matter. In the absence or recusal of the Deputy Chief Justice, the Justice with the most seniority on the Supreme Court of Kentucky shall next be contacted to consider the matter.
