## ORDER

2021-46

**In Re: Limits on Compensation of Master Commissioners for  
Calendar Year 2022**

Under CR 53.07, and in furtherance of the Administrative Procedures of the Court of Justice, Part IV, Commissioners of the Circuit Court, Section 9, the Office of Master Commissioner shall be limited in total yearly compensation derived from fees as set-out in this Order, unless otherwise approved by written order of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Kentucky.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, upon review and recommendation by the Administrative Office of the Courts and consistent with compensation information previously distributed, master commissioners in the following counties shall be entitled to no more than \$53,000 in personal compensation for Calendar Year 2022.
