The child is a status offender or alleged status offender charged with violating a VCO and shall be detained up to 48 hours, exclusive of weekends and holidays, and the Court has reviewed a written report regarding the behavior of the child and the circumstances, and determined that all dispositions other than secure detention are exhausted or are inappropriate pending a detention hearing set for, 2 (within 48 hours).
	VIOLATION OF VALID COURT ORDER (VCO). KRS 630.080. The child is adjudicated to have violated a VCO after an adjudicatory hearing, the Court has reviewed a written report regarding the behavior of the child and the circumstances, and determined that all dispositions other than secure detention are exhausted or are inappropriate, and the child shall be detained for days (not to exceed 30 days) pursuant to KRS 600.060.
	FOLLOWING A DETENTION HEARING. KRS 630.080. The detention hearing established probable cause that the child is a status offender and that further detention is necessary for the protection of the child or the community, and the child shall be placed in a nonsecure setting approved by the Department of Juvenile Justice for days, pending adjudication and disposition.
