Pursuant to KRS Chapter 189A, and by ORDER of the Court, you are hereby notified **your privilege to operate a motor vehicle/motorcycle in the Commonwealth of Kentucky is suspended** this _____ day of _____, 2_____, for the following reason(s) specified in KRS 189A.200:

- Defendant refused to take an alcohol concentration or substance test as reflected on the uniform citation. (Check only one) Defendant is is not required to apply to the Cabinet for issuance of an ignition interlock license pursuant to KRS 189A.200(3)(a);
 - Defendant has been convicted of one or more prior offenses as described in KRS 189A.010(5)(e) in the 10 year period immediately preceding his/her arrest. Defendant shall apply to the Cabinet for issuance of an ignition interlock license pursuant to KRS 189A.200(3)(b);
 - Defendant has had his/her operator's license revoked or suspended on one or more occasions for refusing to take an alcohol concentration or substance test in the 10 year period immediately preceding his/her arrest. Defendant shall apply to the Cabinet for issuance of an ignition interlock license pursuant to KRS 189A.200(3)(b);
- OR
- Defendant was involved in an accident that resulted in death or serious physical injury, as defined in KRS 500.080, to a person other than the Defendant. Defendant shall apply to the Cabinet for issuance of an ignition interlock license pursuant to KRS 189A.200(3)(b).

Your license or privilege to operate a motor vehicle/motorcycle in the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall remain suspended until: you are acquitted, **or** all pending or current charges under KRS 189A.010 have been dismissed, **or** you are convicted and the Transportation Cabinet has suspended your license, but in no event for a period longer than the following license suspension period: (check one)

- 1st offense within a 10 year period = 6 months 2nd offense within a 10 year period = 18 months
- 3rd offense within a 10 year period = 36 months 4th or subsequent offense within a 10 year period = 60 months

Any Kentucky operator's license in your possession MUST BE SURRENDERED to the Court IMMEDIATELY.

Notice to Defendant: You have the right to file a motion for judicial review of this suspension. KRS 189A.200(2)
