- b. Upon entry of this Order to expunge the above-specified records, the proceedings in the case shall be deemed never to have occurred, all index references shall be deleted, and the person and Court may properly reply that no record exists with respect to such offense upon any inquiry in the matter;
- c. The person whose record is expunged shall not have to disclose the fact of the record or any matter relating thereto on an application for employment, credit, or other type of application;
- d. Copies of this Order shall be sent to each of the following agencies or officials:
